- Most used but least seriously taken
























Difference between Hearing and Listening:

Barriers in Listening:













Psychological Barrier-

Prejudice, hasty attitude, egoistic attitude, habit of debate, lack of interest

Environmental Barrier-

space, noise, audience, sound system

Linguistic Barrier-

Ambiguous words, paralinguistic differences, clarity, jargon, lack of common language

Socio-cultural Barrier-

Beliefs and values, Lack of training, ignorance, lack of open mindedness

Physiological Barrier-

overloaded information, stress, auditory mechanism, hunger etc.
