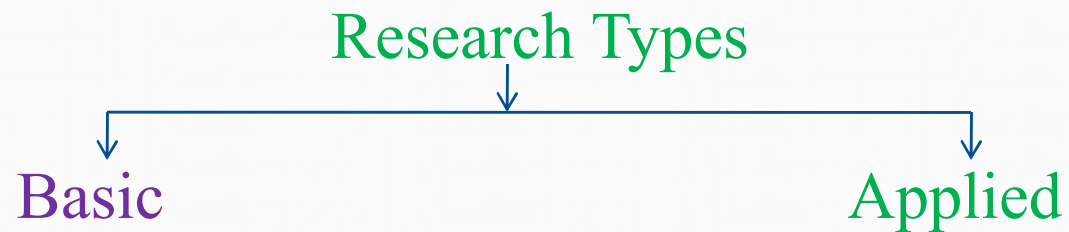

T = Time bond.

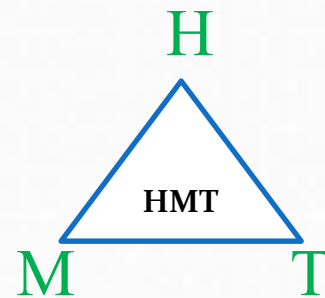
