## DIED AND BURIED FAMILY IN BRITISH INDIA SOCIETY AT AMRAVATI

(Special Study of Catholic Graveyard, Camp Amravati)

**Introduction :** Amravati is loated at 20. 93<sup>o</sup> N. 77. 75<sup>o</sup>c, it has an average elevation of 343 M, (1125 Feet). The ancient name of Amravati is 'Audmbar vati' in prakrut, "Umbravati". The variant Amravati is named for its acient Ambadevi temple, a mention of Amravati can be found on a stone inscription on the base of the marble statue of God (Jain) Adinath, Rhishadnath. The staues date back to the year 1097. Govind Maha Prahu Visited Amravati in 13<sup>th</sup> cent. When wardha was under the rule of Deogiri' s Hindu king (Yadava dynasty)= In the 14<sup>th</sup> Cent, there was drought and famine in Amravati So people abandoned Amravati and left for Malwa dn Gujart. Though some locals returned after sever a year, this resulted in a scantly population. In the 17<sup>th</sup> Cent. Magar Aurangpud/Sabanpura was allotted for a Jama Masjid by Mugal emprer Aurangjeb. In 1722 A. D. Chh. Shahu Presented Amravati Land Bhandara region to Ranoji Bhosla, so Amravati is known as' Bhosle ki Amravati'. The City was reconstructed by Bhosle after treaty of Devgaon and surji Anjan gaon and victory of Gavilgarh / fort Chikhaldara.<sup>1</sup>

The British general and author Wellesly Camped in Amravati, the place is still known Camp Area. By Amravati people. The union state of Nizam and Bhosle ruled Amravati. The appointed a revenue officer but neglected defense. The Gavilgarh as Conquered by Britisher on 15<sup>th</sup> OCT 1803 and warhad was Presented as a token of Friendship to the Nizam king. Warhad was ruled Nizam thereafter. Around 1805 A. D. The Pendharies attacked on Amravati. The Nizam ruled for a more than 50 year (1803-1859). From 1859 to 1871 <sup>2</sup> Many Gov. Buildings were Reconstructed by British. The Railway st was Constructed in 1859 A. D. ,The Commissioner Bungalow in 1860 A. D. , The small Cause court in 1889, the Tahasil and post office were built in 1871 A. D 'The

central Jail, Collector's office, the Rest house and cotton market also built in this decade. <sup>3</sup>

During 1896 A. D. Dadasahed Khaparde, Raghunath Marsing Mudholkar, Sir Moropant Joshi, Prahalad Pant Jog were prominent leader in Amravati. The 13<sup>th</sup> INC held at Amravati During 27-29<sup>th</sup> Dec. 1897

**Christ Graveyard location :** In Amravati Cty old two graveyard located. One is located behind The Shivaji Edu. College, Camp area and other is located near to Gov. Milk dairy, near to church in these two graveyard 46 old graves in first graveyard and 10 in second graveyard. <sup>5</sup>

Peter Chamarett : (Male)** <sup>7</sup> Sacred to the loving memory of Peter Chamertt, retired Civil surgeon of Yevotmal Berar who died at Amravati on The 30<sup>th</sup> July 1905 Aged 79 Years. Erected by his children. And God shall wife Awake. All tears from their eyes and their and there shall be no more death for the former things have passed away. <sup>2</sup> (see photo. 04)

**3. NEWTON MURRAY : (Male)** <sup>8</sup> Sacred to the memory of Newton Murray, superintendent of the Commissioner's office Amoraoti Berar Born 13<sup>th</sup> Oct. 1852, Died 4<sup>th</sup> OCT 1905 erected by his wife. Welt keep him in perfect peace. <sup>3</sup> (see photo. 05)

**4. Rev. J. M. E. Cooke : (male)** <sup>9</sup> In loving memory of the Rev. J. M. E. Cook chaplain who died from cholera on 17 July 1906 Aged 34 Years.

The light of mine eyes is gene from me Erected by his friends as a token of esteem. (see photo. 06)

**5. Robert George Stuart : Male** <sup>10</sup> In memory of Robert George Stuart died 26<sup>th</sup> Aug. 1874 aged 41 years and 7 months. Thy will be done.

**6. John Moreau : (Male)** <sup>11</sup> In every loving memory of John Moreau Born 18/11/1848, died 11/12/1912 A sudden change at God's Command he fell. He had no change. To Bid his dear ones and Friends

Farewell. Affiliation came without warning given and bade him haste to meet his God in heaven.

All over woes and sadness in this world below. Balance no the cladness we in heaven small know. Peace perfect peace. (see photo. No. 10)

**7. Annie Mary : (Female)** <sup>12</sup> Her children arise up, and caller blessed, her husband also and he Braided Here

“In affectionate remembrance of Annie Mary the beloved wife of G.R. Bird, exec. Engs Born on 5<sup>th</sup> Jan. 1860 and Died 11 Jan 1908. Erected by her sorrowing husband and children. (see photo. No. 11.)

**8. Christine M' Guire : Female** <sup>13</sup> In loving memory of our mother Christina M.' Guire who died on the 11/09/1905 Aged 65 years and 14 months. (see photo No, 19)

**9. Mary Ann Bell : Female** <sup>14</sup> In memory of marry Ann Bell. The beloved wife of ex Morton Bell ESQ Assi. engineer Gip Railway who died at OOMRAWUTTEE. 3<sup>rd</sup> April 1860. (see photo no. 19)

**10. Morgaret (female)** <sup>15</sup> This tomb is established in centre of graveyard. This is the largest tomb in graveyard. On this tomb mentioned That, “sacred to memory of Margaret the beloved wife of John Edmon son My lott, civil engi, Gip Railway who departed. This life on 22 Nov. 1861 Aged. 41 Years. (see photo. 22)

**Horallo Syonly T. Charles : (male)** <sup>16</sup> Scared to the memory of Horallo sy only T. Charles who diet suddenly on the 4<sup>th</sup> Jan, 1919 Aged Years.

Just as I am without one plea, but that thy blood was shed for me and that thou biddst me come to thee, lamb of God I come.

Reader trepare to meet they God. (see photo. 23)

**12.—Kane (female):** <sup>17</sup> Wife of late G. N. Kane pleader Amravooti died 1-3-1921 Aged 63. (see photo. 24)

**14. Ellen Margaret<sup>19b</sup> (female):** In memory of Ellen Margaret the loving and true wife of Eustace John Kitts died on the 20<sup>th</sup> Aug 1882. Aged 25 Years.

Best carving the two wings, Cruss and garland on the tomb. (see photo no. 39.)

**21. Adelaide (female)<sup>26</sup>** In loving memory of Adelaide daughter of Joseph Madeira, Born 17<sup>th</sup> Jan, 1861 and Died 20<sup>th</sup> oct 1880, for cet her no or never will we loved her here we lover her still, nor love her less although she cane from us to her eternal Home-Rlp. (see photo no. 40)

**22. Rchibald<sup>27</sup> (male):** Sacred to the memory of infant son of Rachibald Watson Railway contractor who died 3<sup>rd</sup> Sept. 1865. (see photo no. 42.)
