Central Library has an active member of N-List, INFLIBNET through which more than 6000 journals and 300000 E- Books are available to access. OPAC, Network Resource Center, English Laboratory, etc. these facilities help to transfer of Knowledge.

Many activities have taken Place in the Last five Years. Such as Avishkar, CLRAS (College Level Research Assistance Scheme), COC and Acharya Samarpan (Funds created for students as well as Community Development), etc.
