Families In British India Societies - Sources from Christian Graveyard Jalgaon

1.1 Introduction :

Jalgaon District also known as East Khandesh district prior to 21 Oct 1960, was earlier a part of "Khandesh", According to Abdul Fazal, The name of Khandesh is derived from the 'Khan' title given by Ahmad-I of Gujrat ruler (1411-1443 A.D) to Malik Nasir, the second of the Faruki kings. According to some source, the name comes from the Khandwa forest of Mahabhart. In Mahabharata, description mentioned that, the Yuvanshava- The ruler of Nandurbar – Toranmal, fight with the Pandvas. In frist Centuries Khandesh was in the under of partronised Buddhism, it's evidence shows in Caves of Ajanta and Nashik. There after, Khandesh was ruled by the Satvahanas, Andhryabrhatyas, Virsen (the Great King of Ahir), Yawan kings, Chalukyas, Yadavs and then Alauddin Khiji, MohTuglak, Malik Raja, Nizam of Hyderabad, and subsequently the Marthas ruled in the khandesh Region.¹

1.2 The British period and to days Jalgaon Dist :

In the 18th Century, Khandesh was captured by British troops from the Holkar regime with Dhule as the Headquarters. Hon Robert Gill (officer in Native infantry 44, DOB-1804-DoD 10th April 1879, Burried at Christ Catholic Church Cemetery at Bhusawal)² Was the first officer of British EIC in the Khandesh District. After the one year of Bengol Partition, in 1906 Khandesh was devided in to East and West Khandesh. East Khandesh become present day known as Jalgaon. In 1956 with the reconstruction of States on the basis of linguistic, Jalgaon was included in Bombay State. And with the formation of Maharashtra in 1st May 1960, Jalgaon become a district of North Side of State.

1.3 Location of Christian Catholic Church Cemetery Jalgaon :

Christian Catholic Church Cemetery Jalgaon is located in Shivajinagar over bridge, Near Railway Station it is located in parallel side of Jalgaon to Bhusawal Railway track's, on the right side. In this cemetery some tombs, its ruins are existence as a source of families in British India Societies, These are the followings.³

Tomb Epitaphs of Christian Catholic Church Cemetery (4C) Jalgaon (Shivajinagar.)

1.3 Epitaph reading of tomb of 4C Jalgaon :

Families and persons give their life and work for the people of Jalgaon. These British person born any where but died at Jalgaon and buried in 4C during the last two decade of 19th cent. to first quarter of 20th Cent. Reading of epitaphs are followings -

- 1. Marjorie Doreen :-** Details "In loving memory of Marjorie Doreen, daughter of Claude O and Ellen H. Endorson. Died 16th April 1914. Aged 4 Years 10 Months."⁴
This epitaph is carved by Frank Binkp, at Byculla, Bombay. The quite and beautiful girl child sculpture carved in Marble with epitaph. This tomb is all attractive and decorative, it shows that the affectionate of parents towards the daughter.
- 2. Sebastiao Felicio D' Souza :** Description – "In memory of Sebastiao Feliolo D'suza aged 30 Years and a Months. Died 29th Jan 1908 Natvie of Bairosall as vaddo Em Parra Bardez Goa. R.I.P. Erected by Mr. Wary, ex eng^R. To this faithful butler ."⁵
- 3. Walter Maurice :** Description - "In loving memory of walter Maurice the much loved son of Mourice and Clare. WEBB, Born Dec. 19th 1921, Died Dec. 17th 1922. He shall gather the lamb with his arm, and carry them in his bosom."⁶
- 4. Anthony M. Domingo :** Description – "In loving memory of Anthony M. Domlngo eldest son of Mr. and Mrs. P.V. Domingo. Born 5th July 1922 Died 23rd Oct. 1922, Deeply regretted by his present and sisters."⁷
- 5. Ernest A. De Lima :** Details – "In loving memory of Ernest A. De Lima. PWD Dept. (Sind,) Who died on 24th Nov 1919. Aged 16 Years. RIP."⁸
- 6. Cornnen Helen M^cCorthy :** Details – "In loving memory of our darling child Cronnen Helen M^cCorthy who died on the 16th Aug 1897 Aged 9th Months and 6 days We loved Her, Oh no tongue can tell, How much we loved her and how well God loved her too, He thought it best to take her home from pain to rest"⁹
- 7. Donald Heron :** Details – "Donald Heron, Born 21st April 1870 fell A sleep, 30th Jan. 1898 Them also which sleep in Jesus. Will God bring unto Him"¹⁰
- 8. Emma J. Heron :** Details – "Emma J. Heron wife of Donald Heron Born 17th Oct. 1867, fell A sleep 2nd April 1897. Jesus said unto her I am the resurrection and the life."¹¹

- 9. Thomos Right Carr :** Details – "The affectionate remembrance of Thomos Right Carr, Engineer, Born 6th May 1856, At Hunslet leeds, Yorkshire. Died 10th March 1883 Aged 28 Year 10 months, 0 Lord grant



HIM thy eternal Rest.ars 10 months, O, Lord grant HIM thy eternal Rest.”¹²

10. Elin Jhonsonp : Details – “Loving memory of Elin Johnsonp, Born in Sweeden 30th. Sept 1895. Died 7thsept 1933. And they over come by the blood of the Lomb ————— And they loved not their live unto death.”¹³

11. Adc. Hore : Details – “In memory of Adc.Hore, L.C.S Born 15th Dec. 1886. Died at Jalgaon. On 29th may 1912 R.I.P” ¹⁴

12. Maud Word : Details – “In loving memory of Maud word. Born 13th March 1889. Died at Jalgaon. 25th March 1924. Unto Her I am the resurrection and the life.”¹⁵

13. Mirjam Francer Diah Am : Details – “Mirjam Francer Diah Am, Daughter of Rev and mrs. ————— Mam Aged two months and one days —————” ¹⁶

1.4 Conclusions :

4C Jalgaon is small graveyard include 13 existing tombs/with epitaphs. In Jalgaon District Bhusawal is a major station and place to dwell for British and missionary’s people, so 4C graveyard at Bhuswal is main and major place to buried. So many missionaries, Contingent person buried at 4C Bhusawal.

Second 4C at Jalgaon. Best and decorative tomb of quite baby Marjorie Doreen. Statue of childbaby is beautiful carving in marble. (See photograph No. 1)

(Sebastio Felicio D’ Souza)

One person native from Goa (see photo No. 2) but died at Jalgaon. Ernest A.De.Lima (See photo No. 05) and Thomos Right Carr were the engineers (See photo No. 10) Engineer Lima from Sind (Pakistan) and T.R.Carr from Yorkshire (U.K.) Both live and spent their life and died at Jalgaon. Lima was the engineer of public Dept. Of His / Her majesty.

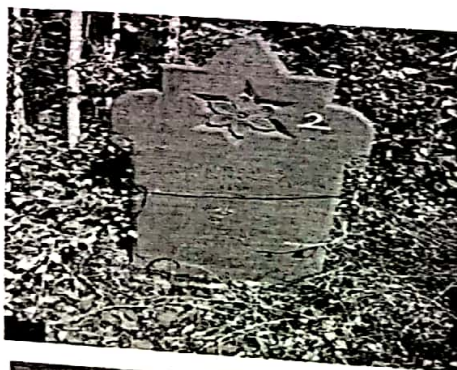

Among the 13 tombs 04 tombs are the tombs of Childs (See photo No. 1, 3, 4 and 6) so it shows that the death ratio in children age was high.
